Detachment Case Load:

January 2024, the Mackenzie RCMP investigated 151 Files (149 files for Jan 2023)
Majority of case load as follows:

Files load for Mackenzie RCMP is on par with the previous year. Responding Mental Health calls continue to place added pressure on Police Resources. There has been an increase in road safety due to extra enforcement in this area as noted by the traffic stats for January
