- "School-based award" is an award given to a student attending a specific secondary school.

Approval forms must be returned to us no later than April 21, 2023 in order to publish the Awards booklet for the students. Students will receive application booklets at the beginning of May and have 3 weeks to apply. Payment for all awards must be received prior to May 31, 2023.

#### Mackenzie Secondary School Local Awards Scholarship & Bursary Criteria

Applications will be accepted based on the following criteria:

- Students must be enrolled in School District No 57
- Students must be planning to attend a post-secondary program.
- Students must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents (landed immigrants) at the time of graduation.
- A student applying for awards must ensure that they are eligible for those awards based on the awards criteria. The Mackenzie Secondary School Graduation Program Advisor can assist students in determining their eligibility for awards.
- Students will be considered only for awards for which they have applied.
- Academic standing in Grades 10,11 and 12 is used in the final selection of recipients of scholarship and bursaries. The courses used to calculate this are:
  - 1. Math 10
  - 2. English 10
  - 3. English 11
  - 4. English 12
  - 5. Math 11 or 12
  - 6. Social Studies 11 or 12
  - 7. Science 11 or 12
  - 8. 3 Grade 12 courses
  - 5 courses (or 20 credits) from the best
     Remaining Grade 11/12 courses. If the
     Student does not have enough Grade 11/12 courses, the remaining credits can come from the best Grade 10 courses, including Career Life Education.

#### NOTE:

- Students applying for bursaries should have no less than a C+ average (67%)
- Students applying for scholarships should have no less than a B average (73%).

#### To receive their awards, students must:

- o Be attending class full time at a college, university or other post-secondary program.
- O Provide the Mackenzie Secondary School Awards Committee with a "confirmation of full-time enrollment" letter from the registrar's office of the post-secondary institution they are attending, stating they are in attendance on a full-time basis, the dates of the school year and the program in which they are enrolled.
- O Provide the Mackenzie Secondary School Awards Committee with copies of all thank you letter(s) they sent to award donor(s).
