Subject:	Referral 7410366 – Logging Camp Permit Renewal

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

THAT Council directs Administration on how to respond to the referral request.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The District has received a referral from the Province of BC looking for comments with respect to to Conifex Timber's application to renewal of their License of Occupation for their existing Swannell Camp operation located north-west of Mackenzie on the other side of Williston Lake (see attached maps and management plan).

#### **DETAILS**:

<u>Proponent</u>: Conifex Timber Inc. <u>Authorization Type</u>: License of Occupation <u>Purpose/Intended Use/background context</u>: Operation of Existing Logging Camp <u>BCGS Mapsheet</u>: 94C.075 <u>Location or Project Name</u>: Ingenika Mine <u>Area (ha):</u> 10.70

### **EXCERPT FROM MANAGEMENT PLAN:**

No new development to occur. Updating the existing Special Use Permit (SUP) tenure to comply with new legislative requirements for Logging Camps. Original SUP has existed since July 1, 1997. In 2019 an extension request for the site was approved, and new camp infrastructure was moved in. The camp is currently used seasonally (summer) for various forestry contractors and machine operators. In addition to the camp infrastructure (main camp trailers, well house, septic bed and fuel), temporary RV trailers may be set up on site by various contractors. No changes/improvements are being applied for with this application.



## **STAFF LAND USE COMMENTS:**

As the application does not occur within the District of Mackenzie border, there are no District permitting, zoning, or official community plan requirements or concerns.

### COUNCIL'S RECOMMENDATION:

Based on the information presented, Council is being asked by the Province to provide comment. We are given the following options for response:
