Mayors Report for September 2025:

Detachment Case Load:

September 2025 the Mackenzie RCMP investigated 148 files. (146 files from previous year)

Community Policing:

In line with the Annual Performance Plan initiative for Crime Prevention through Curfew Compliance checks, the Mackenzie RCMP members conduct curfew and house arrest checks. Offender is in Custody, no checks required. Mackenzie's prolific offender is in Custody on charges stemming from Mackenzie.

Mackenzie RCMP have been conducting School Zone Patrols almost daily. This has proven effective deterrent in vehicles not stopping for the School Bus. Mackenzie RCMP have also completed 5 School visits and provided Traffic control for Morfee Elementary and High School Terry Fox Runs.
