Mayors Report for October 2025:

Detachment Case Load:

October 2025 the Mackenzie RCMP investigated 131 files. (178 files from previous year)
Majority of case load as follows:

Traffic Enforcement: - October 2025 Traffic Stats:

8 violation tickets issued

34 warnings issued.

Majority of warnings were Speeding within a Municipality and no Drivers Licence.

2 Impaired operation investigations.

Community Policing:

In line with the Annual Performance Plan initiative for Crime Prevention through Curfew Compliance checks, the Mackenzie RCMP members conducted 3 curfew and house arrest checks on 2 Offenders. Both Offenders placed on House arrest at the end of October which resulted in lower than normal compliance checks.

Mackenzie RCMP have been conducting School Zone Patrols almost daily. This has proven effective deterrent in vehicles not stopping for the School Bus.
