



## **COUNCIL REPORT**

**Subject:** Public Works Month End Report for January 2026

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### **WATER DISTRIBUTION:**

Pumphouses delivered 13,160,061 US gallons of water into the water tower during the month of January, the equivalent of 424,518.10 gallons per day, which is approximately 320.15 gallons per water connection. Last year pumphouses delivered 11,274,726 US gallons of water into the water tower during the month of January, the equivalent of 363,700.84 gallons per day or 274.28 gallons per connection.

*Gantahaz Water System:* Pumphouse delivered 439,857 US gallons of water into the tower during the month of January, the equivalent of 14,188.95 gallons per day, which is approximately 159.43 gallons per water connection. Last year Pumphouse delivered 497,046 US gallons of water during the month of January, the equivalent of 16,033.75 gallons per day, which is approximately 180.15 gallons per connection.

### **SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEMS:**

There were 4 good neighbor sewer calls to report for the month of January.

### **GARBAGE COLLECTION SYSTEMS:**

The total commercial garbage collected for the month of January was 57,310 kg. The total residential garbage collected was 45,340 kg, for a total of 102,650 kg. The total commercial garbage collected in January 2025 was 54,050 kg. The total residential garbage collected for January 2025 was 46,010 kg, for a total of 100,060 kg.

### **SNOWFALL ACCUMULATIONS:**

Snowfall accumulation for January was 17.75 inches.



### **STREETS AND ROADS:**

- Snow Removal ongoing throughout town.
- Snow Blower has been widening the roads.
- Loaders are busy clearing sight lines.
- Dealing with ice buildup on streets, paths and sidewalks.
- Busy trying to keep catch basins open for drainage.

### **PARKS:**

- Last day of work Oct 24, 2025. Closed for the season.

### **PROJECTS:**

- Due to amount of snow, ice and rain Public Works priority for the month of January was snow removal, paths, sidewalks and roads.
- Keep catch basins free of ice to ensure runoff.

### **EQUIPMENT & MAINTENANCE:**

- Mechanics have been busy with routine maintenance on winter equipment.
- New Bylaw pickup was put into the fleet.
- Red Groomer was taken out of service and needs repairs and parts.

### **BUILDINGS:**

- Snow removal from doorways, paths and parking lots.
- Dealing with ice and water build up.

### **SAFETY:**

- OH&S/Joint Health and Safety Committee meeting was held on January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

**COMPLAINT/SERVICE FILES:**

**#001-2026 – Dog at Large / Impound**
